plasma) can interfere. It is recommended that patients refrain from taking excessive amounts of vitamin C or vitamin C rich food for at

least 48 hours prior to collection

Container/Tube: Red top tube

Preferred Specimen Type: Serum

Acceptable Specimen Type: Plasma collected in a Green top tube (Sodium Heparin)

Specimen Volume: 2 mL

Collection Instructions:

- Draw blood in a plain, red-top tube(s) or Green top tube (Sodium Heparin). Polymer gel separation tubes (SST or PST) are not acceptable.
- 2. Spin down and send 2 mL of serum or plasma in a plastic vial (preservative-free).

Minimum Volume: 0.7 mL
