

Anti-Collagen type VII, IgG antibodies, Serum

Useful for:

Initial screening test in the diagnosis of epidermolysis bullosa acquisita and other immunobullous diseases mediated by collagen VII.

Methods:

Enzyme-Linked Immunosorbent Assay (ELISA)

Reference Values:

Collagen type VII <20 RU/mL (negative) > or =20 RU/mL (positive)

Preferred:	Serum gel
Acceptable:	Red top
Specimen Volume:	2 mL
Collection Instructions:	Centrifuge and aliquot serum into a plastic vial.
Minimum Volume:	0.5 mL
