

# **Beta-Glucuronidase, Blood Spot**

# Useful for:

Supporting the biochemical diagnosis of mucopolysaccharidosis VII (MPS VII, Sly syndrome)

This test is not useful for determining carrier status for MPS VII.

#### **Genetics Information:**

This test provides diagnostic testing for individuals with clinical signs and symptoms suspicious for mucopolysaccharidosis type VII (MPS VII, Sly syndrome). If an enzyme deficiency is detected by this test, additional biochemical or molecular testing is required to confirm a diagnosis.

Liquid Chromatography Tandem Mass Spectrometry (LC-MS/MS)

Acceptable:	Whatman Protein Saver 903 Paper, PerkinElmer 226 filter paper, Munktell filter paper, or blood collected in tubes containing ACD or EDTA and dried on filter paper.

Collection Instructions:	<ol> <li>An alternative blood collection option for a patient 1 year of age or older is a fingerstick. See How to Collect Dried Blood Spot Samples via fingerstick.</li> <li>At least 2 spots should be complete (ie, unpunched).</li> <li>Let blood dry on filter paper at room temperature in a horizontal position for a minimum of 3 hours.</li> <li>Do not expose specimen to heat or direct sunlight.</li> <li>Do not stack wet specimens.</li> <li>Keep specimen dry.</li> </ol>
