

Varicella-Zoster Virus Antibody, IgG, CSF

Explanation: Per notification from Arup Laboratories, effective October 7, 2024, the test will experience the following changes to reference ranges.

Current Reference Ranges	New Reference Ranges
134.9 IV or less: Negative - No significant level of IgG antibody to varicella-zoster virus detected.	0.9 S/CO or less: Negative - No significant level of detectable varicella-zoster IgG antibody.
135.0 - 164.9 IV: Equivocal - Repeat testing in 10 - 14 days may be helpful.	1.0 S/CO or greater: Positive - IgG antibody to varicella-zoster virus detected, which may indicate a current or past varicella-zoster infection.
165.0 IV or greater: Positive - IgG antibody to varicella-zoster virus detected, which may indicate a current or past varicella-zoster infection.
