Explanation: Effective February 10, 2025, test ID FBMO, referred to Miravista Diagnostics, will reflect the following changes:

Current Cautions

Cross-reactions are seen with histoplasmosis, paracoccidioidomycosis, penicilliosis, less frequently in coccidiooidomycosis, rarely in aspergillosis and possibly sporotrichosis.

Sputolysin, sodium hydroxide, and potassium hydroxide treatment degrade the analyte detected in the assay

New Cautions

When tested in cultures of 10⁵ (1,000,000)–10⁶ (10,000,000) organisms/mL, cross-reactions occurred with Histoplasma spp., Coccidioides spp., Paracoccidioides brasiliensis, Talaromyces marneffei, Aspergillus nidulans, and Candida tropicalis.
