Explanation: Per notification from Arup Laboratories, effective April 21, 2025, this test will experience the following changes to reference ranges.

Current Reference Ranges
0.9 S/CO or less: Negative - No significant level of detectable varicella-zoster IgG antibody.
1.0 S/CO or greater: Positive - IgG antibody to varicella-zoster detected, which may indicate a current or past varicella-zoster infection.

New Reference Ranges
0.99 S/CO or less: Negative - No significant level of detectable varicella-zoster IgG antibody.
1.00 S/CO or greater: Positive - IgG antibody to varicella-zoster detected, which may indicate a current or past varicella-zoster infection.
